

BASKETBALL RULES

Teams are responsible for reading the rules for this league and abiding by them at all times.

Rule #1 – Have fun

Rule #2 – Worry more about meeting people and being social than the score

• That's less rules than Fight Club so it should be clear the focus is to meet new friends while playing the greatest game on earth... well maybe not the greatest but you get the point.

General Overview

- Players who have not signed the waiver or paid are unable to participate.
- Teams will have until 10 minutes past the designated start time to field a team. Teams are allowed to play with a minimum of 4 players as long as there are still 2 females on the court at all times. Full teams will consist of a minimum of 7 registered players.
- Substitutions: There are unlimited amount of substitutions per game. Subs may enter at any stoppage of play or after a point is scored. Teams are allowed to pick up 2 non rostered subs in order to field a team during the regular season only.
- ➤ Play two 20 minute halves. Clock DOES NOT stop until the last minute of each half.

 If a game has a margin of more than 20 points then the clock will not stop at the end of the game.
- Teams are allowed 3 timeout per game.
- > Overtime will consist of one minute.
- Free throws will play off the release of the ball.
- Each player gets 5 fouls.
- ➤ Technical Fouls: A player will be removed from the game after two technical fouls and possibly after the first depending on the severity.
- Teams must take the ball to the back court line at all times before making it rain.
- The beginning of the game will start with a jump ball between the shortest players on each team, but must be gender matching. Tall people have had enough jump ball fun.
- No dunking unless it's a 360 windmill and don't be that guy who slaps the backboard if you're still able to jump that high. Both will result in a foul an no points scored.
- ➤ Pics must be gender specific. Ex- males can only set pics for males. Arms must be at the sides and no moving pics.
- ➤ OTS Yell rule is a team foul Don't be the guy who yells "hey" really loud when someone is about to drain a three.
- ≥ 25 second shot clock we're asking a lot from a referee now, so keep this in mind please.
- ➤ Un-sportsman like conduct is not tolerated. Players and teams will be removed from the league if they demonstrate "Rasheed Wallace" like behavior.
